

Seminar: *The Quest for Wisdom: Insights from N. Sri Ram*

N. Sri Ram (1889-1973)

Sri Ram was the fifth President of the Theosophical Society (Adyar), from 1953 till his death in 1973. Originally much involved in the educational and political work of Annie Besant, the second President of the TS, he later became her private secretary. During his Presidency he contributed to a fresh understanding of Theosophy, not only as an ageless teaching, but also as a living Wisdom, relevant to our daily lives. He showed that there is no essential contradiction between the teachings of J. Krishnamurti, for whom he had the highest regard, and those of Theosophy. Sri Ram is generally highly regarded for his deep spiritual wisdom.

In this seminar, we will explore together some subjects of the practical and transformative wisdom in N. Sri Ram's books, through talks, meditative enquiries and dialogues: *Seeking Wisdom, Freedom from Opposites, Meeting Death as a Friend, and The Song of Life*.

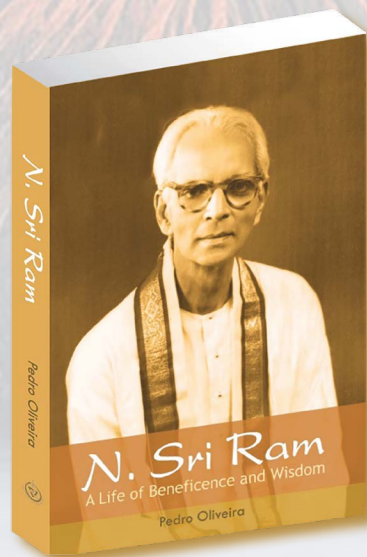

Please bring your own sandwiches.

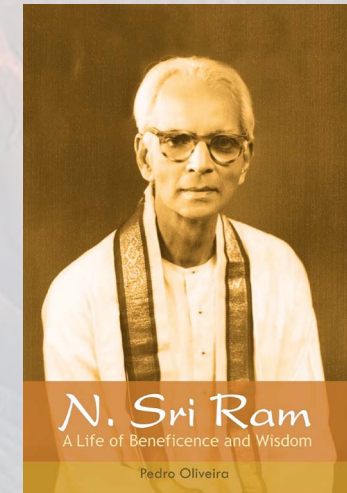
